ORDER

The Court has before it Plaintiffs' Motion to Conditionally Certify Class, Order Disclosure of Putative Class Members' Names and Contact Information, and to Facilitate Class Notice. The Court now rules as follows.

Plaintiffs brought this putative class action against Defendants TPS Communications and Robert Locklear, to recover unpaid wages and overtime allegedly owed to them and other similarly-situated employees who have worked at TPS Communications as tower hands, tower techs, and other positions in a full-time capacity performing telecommunications and construction work within the past three (3) years.

The Court finds that Plaintiffs have made "substantial allegations that the putative class members were together the victim of a single decision, policy or plan." The proposed notice

adequately advises potential plaintiffs of the their rights in this matter.


THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion to Conditionally Certify Class, Order Disclosure of Putative Class Members' Names and Contact Information, and to Facilitate Class Notice is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs' collective action class is conditionally certified pursuant to 29 U.S.C. §216(b) of the FLSA.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall produce to Plaintiffs a list of all potential class members including the last known mailing address and telephone numbers (if known) within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order in a readable electronic data file format.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs are authorized to send notice of this suit to potential opt-in plaintiffs and plaintiff's consent form in a format substantially identical to Exhibit 3.
